3 AUTHORISED VEHICLES

3.1.1 All vehicles that comply with the regulations of Appendix J of the FIA or the AMF for the following groups are authorized to take part to the event:

Category 1: Vehicles according to the current FIA regulations of PF classes 1-5

additional PF groups according to AMF & Slovenian championship regulations

Group 1 Pf 15 to 39 Group 2 Pf 40 to 79 Group 3 Pf 80 to 119

Group 4 Pf 120 to 159 Group 5 Pf 159 to 219

AMF Group: 6 Pf over 219

SVN groups: 5a PF 160 to 300 / 5b PF over 300

Category 2: Vehicles according to the current FIA regulations of PF classes 1-4

Group P1 Pf 50 to 59 Group P2 Pf 60 to 89 Group P3 Pf 90 to 109

Group P4 Pf over 109

All vehicles entered for an event will also be ranked according to their performance classification. In order to check the applicability of the so-called performance factor according to the FIA, it is necessary to state this factor and the current PF-ID "Y6____" on the entry form for each event.

For Slovenian participants with category 2 vehicles, the regulations of the Slovenian ASN Division 1 apply.

3.1.2 Historic vehicles that were manufactured / homologated between 01.01.1947 and 31.12.1990, have a historic FIA/AMF-HTP, and comply with the conditions of "Appendix K" of the FIA and the regulations of the AMF in one of the periods listed below are permitted:

Periods E, F, G1, G2, H1, H2, I, J1, J2 and C, D, E, F, GR, HR, IR and JR.

Historic vehicles from periods A and B are also eligible to start, but are not eligible for the HÖABM; the organizer reserves the right to classify them. For vehicles of the J1/J2 period (J2 1986 and 1987), Appendix XI of FIA Appendix K applies.

For Slovenian participants with vehicles in the historic classes, the regulations of the Slovenian ASN apply.

- 3.1.3 In addition, vehicles according to national technical specifications and class regulations of an FIA ASN are authorized to start. E.g. CTC or E2-SS with wheels wrapped by the bodywork. Classification is based on the PF factor.
- 3.2.1 Category 1 vehicles are divided into performance factor classes from 1 to 6. Category 2 vehicles are divided into performance factor classes from 1 to 4.
- 3.2.2 The historic vehicles of the periods E, F, G1, GR, G2, H1, HR, H2, I, IR, J1, J2, JR, C, D, E, F, GR, HR, IR and JR single-seaters are categorized in accordance with FIA Appendix K.
- 3.2.3 For all other advertised championships and cups, the authorizations apply in accordance with the approved announcements.
- **3.6** Any form of tyre and/or rim heating before the start is prohibited and may result in sanctions, including exclusion from the event.











6 NAMING, RESPONSIBILITY AND INSURANCE

6.1 Entries will only be accepted online via the organizer's entry system from the date of publication of this invitation to tender. Further explanations can also be found on the homepage of the event.

The current PF factor ID "Y6...." is required to submit the entry form. For categories 1 and 2 as well as the license data electronically. Incomplete entries cannot be accepted.

Electronic entries must be confirmed in writing by the entry deadline with any additional information required on the official entry form.

6.2 The maximum number of participants authorized is **250** drivers. Entries received in excess of the limited number of participants will be placed on a waiting list after receipt of the entry fee and prioritized if a participant has not paid the entry fee in time (by the entry deadline).

13 PRIZES AND TROPHIES, AWARD CEREMONY

13.1 Prizes and trophies

13.1.1 trophies will be awarded for the first 3 drivers classified in each class

Cash and trophy prizes must be collected in person at the prize-giving ceremony in the paddock tent. If the prizes are not collected, they will be forfeited in favor of the organizers

prize money is provided (participants in the historic competition will receive trophies)! The prizes listed are not cumulative.

13.2 Award ceremony

13.2.2 Directly after the vehicle retrieval after race heat 2, a flower ceremony will take place in front of the Tulwitz municipal office.

The award ceremony with trophy and prize money will take place on April 27th, 2025 approx. 45 minutes after publication of the official overall standings in the paddock tent.

14 SPECIAL PROVISIONS

14.1 Additional regulations

- 14.1.2 A digital driver information / driver briefing is planned for Thursday April 24th. This written document will be made available with the **Sportity APP** (retrievable with the **code "RBR25"** and on the online notice board of the <u>ORGANISERS HOMEPAGE</u>. Any open questions from participants must be submitted in writing to the event secretariat by Tuesday, April 23th. These will be answered online as part of the driver information. Any unanswered questions can be submitted in writing during the administrative scrutineering and will also be answered online by the start of the practice runs at the latest
- 14.1.3 Paddock speed limit rule: 30 km/h applies in the paddock for the entire duration of the competition. Any detected and/or confirmed case of infringement by the competitor/rider or his team member within the boundaries of the existing paddock, the offence will be reported to the stewards who may impose a penalty at their discretion.
- 14.1.4 After each of the heats (training and race), the PARC FERME regulations apply for the return drive from the finish to the start. The return drive takes place between an leading vehicle of the organizer and the closing vehicle.
- 14.1.5 When reversing, drivers must maintain a safe distance and wear their seat belts. For safety reasons, the distance to the vehicle in front must always be kept constant. Under no circumstances it is permitted to carry passengers in the vehicle. Drivers of open vehicles must wear a helmet and fasten the seatbelt. Overtaking and stopping is prohibited during the return drive.
- 14.1.6 Failing to comply with the above regulations is considered negligent endangerment. This can lead to far-reaching sanctions up to and including disqualification. These points are penalized at the discretion of the stewards.
- 14.1.7 Damaged but running cars can be brought back within the convoy of the return drive to the paddock. Vehicles that are not in a drivable condition must be kept at a safe distance from the track and can only be returned to the paddock after the race, unless the race organizers decide otherwise.
- 14.1.8 Before the start of training or the race, the vehicles must be supplied with sufficient fuel for the length of 2 trips and the return drive.
- 14.1.9 Waste oil and other liquids used in vehicles must be disposed of in special drums, provided in the paddock. Other waste must be disposed in an environmentally friendly manner in the containers provided. Drivers are obliged to use liquid-impermeable tarpaulins under the vehicles. The minimum dimensions are 3 x 4 meters. Failure to use the tarpaulins will be penalized with a fine of € 150.
